2013-14

Played in all 37 games, making one start (versus Oregon, Feb. 27) ... averaged 9.4 points, 2.5 rebounds and 1.8 assists per game ... captured Pac-12 All-Freshman Team honors ... shot 44.1 percent from the field, including 37.5 percent from three-point range ... finished his freshman campaign making 48 of 128 three-point attempts, the second-highest number of three-point field goals by a freshman in UCLA history (trailing Jason Kapono's school-freshman-record 82 three-pointers in 1999-00) ... scored in double figures in 17 games, including nine of his first 10 games ... was named to the 2013 Continental Tire Las Vegas Invitational All-Tournament Team after having averaged 19.5 points in two games at Orleans Arena ... scored a season-high 21 points against Nevada (Nov. 28) ... grabbed a season-high eight rebounds against Oregon (Feb. 27) ... shot 8 for 12 in UCLA's conference win over Arizona State (Jan. 12), finishing with 19 points and having shot 3-for-3 from three-point range ... shot 7-for-17 with 18 points and eight rebounds in a season-high 48 minutes in UCLA's double-overtime loss to Oregon (Feb. 27) ... made a season-best four three-pointers in consecutive games – shot 4-for-6 from three-point territory against Nevada (Nov. 28), one day before shooting 4-for-5 from long-distance against Northwestern (Nov. 29) in a pair of Continental Tire Las Vegas Invitational games at Orleans Arena ... made at least two three-point baskets in 15 games ... opened his freshman season having made 19 of 34 three-point field goal attempts (55.9 percent) in his first eight games ... scored 14 points in UCLA's win at Washington (March 6), logging 11 of UCLA's last 14 points in the game's final 4:39 to help the Bruins expand on a six-point cushion.

High School

Three-year varsity basketball letterwinner at Bothell High School (Bothell, Wash.) under head coach Ron Bollinger ... named the 2013 Associated Press Washington state player of the year as a senior ... averaged 28.5 points, 3.4 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game as a senior ... earned Class 4A all-state honors as a senior, in addition to being named the state of Washington's "Mr. Basketball" by the Washington Interscholastic Basketball Coaches Association in March 2013 ... helped guide Bothell to a 21-5 overall record and 13-1 league mark in 2012-13 ... was invited to participate in the inaugural West Coast All-Star Classic at the ShoWare Center in Kent, Wash., in the spring of 2013 ... as a junior (2011-12), led Bothell to the Class 4A state playoffs and averaged just over 23.0 points per game ... as a sophomore (2010-11), registered 25.9 points per game ... was ranked No. 27 overall in his high school class, nationally, by Scout.com in the fall of 2012 ... also was ranked No. 51 overall by ESPN.com ... was listed as the No. 1 shooting guard on the West Coast by Scout.com and the No. 6 point guard, nationally, by Scout.com ... listed as the No. 1 high school senior in the state of Washington by ESPN.com and the No. 6 player on the West Coast by ESPN.com ... played AAU Basketball for Friends of Hoop (FOH) Seattle.
